The PFJF Framework

I. Peace

- Outlaw war and genocide
 - No individual can take a nation to war
 - Global peacekeeping force composed of all nations
 - Protection of children from hunger and preventable death
 - Nonviolence as political method
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II. Freedom

- Free and fair elections everywhere
 - Universal candidate access
 - Freedom from censorship
 - Reform of sovereignty to prevent internal repression
 - Consent of the governed as legitimacy
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III. Justice

- Equal protection of law globally
 - Anti-corruption systems at all levels
 - Reform of the UN Security Council
 - Binding enforcement of human rights
 - Accountability mechanisms for governments
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IV. Fairness

- Reasonable taxation limits

- Transparent public finance
 - Sustainability of planetary resources
 - Universal service to strengthen civic equality
 - Equal political voice for all nations and peoples
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V. Institutional Vehicle

- UN 2.0
 - Planetary Constitution
 - Democratic representation at planetary level
 - Updated Universal Declaration of Human Rights
 - Long-term peaceful political transition
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VI. Implementation Strategy

- Global public discussion on sovereignty
 - Creation of a global political movement
 - Educational and media outreach
 - Multi-decade nonviolent reform strategy
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
