We reject dogmatism and blind allegiance to ideology. No belief, institution, or authority is beyond question. We encourage open inquiry, honest dialogue, critical thinking, and the peaceful exchange of ideas.

The PFJF movement imposes no religious, political, or philosophical doctrine upon anyone. People of many cultures, faiths, backgrounds, and worldviews can stand together within the movement so long as they embrace nonviolence, human dignity, and the sanctity of all human life.

We believe science is humanity's best method for understanding the natural universe because it is based on evidence, testing, reproducibility, and revision when new facts emerge. Yet we also recognize that knowledge evolves. Any conclusion may be reconsidered if rigorous, reproducible evidence leads toward a deeper understanding of truth.

We believe wisdom requires humility — the willingness to admit error, to learn, and to grow.

The PFJF movement seeks a world where conflicts are resolved through reason, compassion, democratic dialogue, and peaceful action rather than hatred, violence, corruption, or oppression.

We believe that no nation, race, religion, class, or ideology has greater inherent value than another. Every human being possesses dignity and worth.

Our goal is not ideological conformity, but peaceful coexistence built upon truth, fairness, freedom, accountability, and respect for life.
